

*Restriction of Certain Hazardous Substances
in Electrical and Electronic Equipment*

European Union Directive 2002/95/EC (“RoHS”)

Thank you for your recent request for information regarding the compliance status of products that we supply to your organization under the European Union Restriction of Hazardous Substances in Electronics Directive (2002/95/EC) and amending legislation.

As you are aware, this legislation does not apply to all Electrical and Electronic equipment, but rather only to selective categories listed by generic type. As a manufacturer of Medical Devices (Category 8) and/or Control/Monitoring (Category 9) equipment, our products are currently exempt from the scope of the legislation. As such, our products comply with the mandates of the Directive insofar as they have been exempted from its provisions. In addition, consumable items such as tips, reservoirs, racks, tubes and manual pipettors do not fall with the scope of the RoHS directive, as they are not electronic products.

We are aware that the initial exemptions may be removed, and we have developed plans to assess the status of our products and to implement changes in the event that they become required.
